6 companies win construction contract of high-speed railway

Jan 8, 2008

Six companies have successfully won the bid for the construction contracts for the Shanghai-Beijing high-speed railway project worth of RMB 83.7 billion (US\$11.5 billion), the Railway Engineering Business Center announced yesterday. The biggest winner, the China Railway Construction Company Ltd, has won the deal valued at RMB 33.74 billion.

Asia's largest junction station to start construction

Jan 14, 2008

Nanjing South Station has entered its construction phase on January 9 2008. After the construction, the junction station of Beijing-Shanghai high-speed railway will become Asia's largest railway junction station, six times as large as the existing Nanjing Station, China's People's Daily reported.

China to build Beijing-Shijiazhuang express railway

Jan 14, 2008

The railway connecting Beijing and Shijiazhuang, the capital of north China's Hebei Province, will start to construct in June this year, and is expected to complete in four years. The project aims to alleviate transport pressure on northern end of Beijing-Guangzhou railway, a north-south trunk route, and enhance the development of neighboring areas of Beijing.

China to construct a new tunnel under Yangtze River

Jan 30, 2008

China plans to build a new tunnel under the Yangtze River, which is the second river tunnel in Wuhan, capital of China's Hubei Province. The new 27.73-km long underwater tunnel will start from Jiyuqiao in Wuchang and Fanhu in Hankou, namely the capital city's political and commercial centre. The construction is expected to begin in March.

China Railway Construction wins 2 contracts in Libya

Feb 18, 2008

China Railway Construction Corp. (CRCC), has won two construction contracts worth US\$2.6 billion in total in Libya.

China to build Nanjing-Shanghai high-speed railway

Feb 22, 2008

A high-speed inter-city passenger rail link between Nanjing and Shanghai will break ground in the first half of this year, said Zhang Xiaoling, deputy chief with Jiangsu Provincial Office of Railways. The project, with total budget about RMB 42.2 billion (US\$5.78 billion), has got green light from the National Development and Reform Commission.

CRCC raises HK\$18.3 bln in HK IPO

Mar 7, 2008

China Railway Construction Corp (CRCC), China's largest railway and construction contractor, raised HK\$18.3 billion (US\$2.35 billion) in its Hong Kong IPO.

Beijing-Lhasa luxury train to begin operations in Sep

Mar 10, 2008

A luxurious train between China's capital Beijing and Tibet's capital Lhasa will start operation from Sep. 1. The train's interior decoration will follow the standards of a five-star hotel.

China to build Beijing-Fujian railway

Mar 12, 2008

China plans to build a railway connecting Beijing with the southeastern province of Fujian, to develop the coastal region close to Taiwan. The planned railway, with designed speed at 300 kms per hour, will start from Bengbu city in eastern Anhui Province and end in Fuzhou, the capital of Fujian Province.
