**Hangzhou Launches First VC-participated Cooperation Fund with Initial Scale of RMB100M**

The first cooperation fund involving VC equity participation in the Hangzhou Economic & Technological Development Zone was launched in Xiasha, with an initial scale of RMB100M. The fund will mainly go to the early and expansion stage enterprises within the Zone.

**Centurion to Launch Two Private Equity Funds**

The boutique Asian private equity firm, Centurion Investment Management, intends to begin fundraising in the next two months for a China-focused RMB fund and an Asia-focused fund.

**BOC International to Set up Domestic Media Fund**

9 Jul 2009

BOC International Holdings Ltd, the flagship investment banking arm of Bank of China (601988.SS) (3988.HK), will set up a private equity fund focusing on the domestic media industry.

**Thompson National to Launch Green Property Fund**

10 Jul 2009

Thompson National Properties plans to launch a fund worth several hundred million dollars focusing on real estate assets across the United States and Asia.

**Keytone Ventures Raises US\$200M for First Fund**

14 Jul 2009

Focuses on early growth investments in the technology, clean-tech, media and consumer sectors in China, Beijing-based Keytone Ventures raised US\$200 million for the final close of its first fund.

**Venture Capital Fund-Raising Plunges In First Half**

The amount of capital raised by U.S. venture capital firms plunged in the first half of 2009, as cash-strapped investors stopped committing to the private equity asset class.

**Navis Asia Fund Halfway To Target**

**DT Capital Partners Allies with Chengdu Yinke to Launch RMB500M Baby Fund**

A fund guided by the Chengdu Municipal People's Government Yinke Venture Capital, inked an agreement with DT Capital Partners, a venture capital conglomerate in China, on the setup of a RMB500M venture capital fund on Jul. 16.

**Fund Gets US\$659 Million for Frontier Markets**

22 Jul 2009

A new Chinese government-backed investment firm is raising two 4.5 billion yuan (US\$658.8 million) funds for investments focused on Chinese frontier markets including Xinjiang, Tibet, Heilongjiang and Yunnan.

**MBK Partners Raises US\$1.6 Billion for Asian Fund**

Private-equity firm MBK Partners LP raised US\$1.6 billion for its second fund, matching the size of its first fund.

**Pitango Eyes US\$100-200M China Fund**

23 Jul 2009

Israel's venture capital giant Pitango plans to team up with a Chinese partner to launch a US\$100-US\$200 million fund with investment focus on China's start-up companies.

**Tiantu Capital PE Fund III Launched with Registered Capital of RMB300M**

Tiantu Capital PE Fund III, the new fund will adopt the corporate system, and use the name of Shenzhen Tiantu Xingrui Venture Capital Co., Ltd., with a registered capital of RMB300M. Among 20 shareholders in the new company, five are enterprises and the remaining are natural persons.

**SinoLatin Launches Firm Focused on China-Latin America Transactions**

Shanghai International Group, the city's government-funded investment firm, will soon launch a private equity firm that will focus on financial sector investments, a person close to SIG said.

**SAIF Fund to Inject US\$25M into Guangdong Yinda for 25% Equity**

Guangdong Yinda, a joint venture between state-owned Canton Venture Capital Co., Ltd. and private capital, has blazed a trail that government fund plays a guiding role and private capital undertakes guarantee and opened up the operating mode that combines credit guarantee and venture capital. A source with Guangdong Yinda reveals that the company will set up a few subsidiaries in the Yangtze River Delta Region

**NYGG Joins Hands with M.D.Witter Investments Setting up Witter Global Opportunity Fund**
